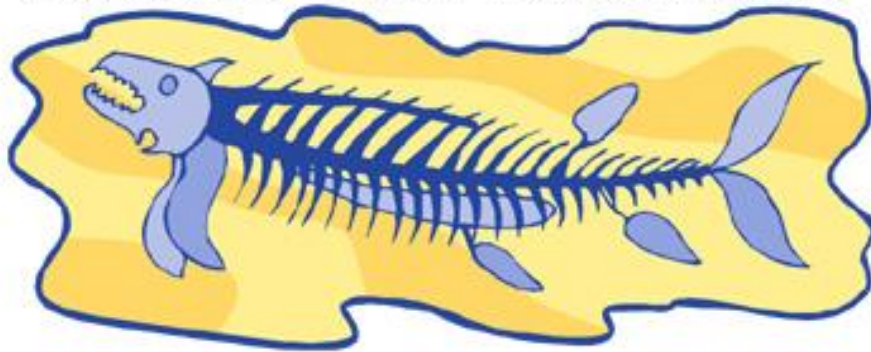


Animals With Backbones

Fish are one kind of animal with a backbone. Sharks, salmon, and tuna are different types of fish. They all have backbones.



Amphibians are another kind of animal with a backbone. Frogs, toads, and salamanders are different types of amphibians. They all have backbones.

Birds are another kind of animal with a backbone. Ducks, owls, and eagles are different types of birds. They all have backbones.



Mammals are another kind of animal with a backbone.

Horses, wolves, and humans are different types of mammals.
