Classes 2022

Students in Years 1 to 6 return to school on Tuesday 1st February 2022 (Kindy start on Monday 7th February at 9.30am). Until we are able to finalise student enrolments and numbers (normally sometime during the first full week), students will not be in their 2022 classes, but will remain in their 2021 classes. This enables us to confirm our numbers in each class before the students are placed with their teacher. A note will go home informing you of your child's class and teacher as soon as the classes are formed. For the first day of school, we anticipate that the children will follow the same morning procedure as in 2021. They will line up in their 2021 class lines with their 2021 class teacher, where possible.

Kindergarten 2022

Our modified 3 week transition program concluded last Thursday and our new Kindy students have only a few weeks before they start school in earnest! School commences at 9.30am on Monday 7th February for our Kindy students, with Best Start assessments conducted on Tuesday 1st February, Wednesday 2nd February, Thursday 3rd February and Friday 4th February 2022. Please contact the school office if you have not received notification of your child's Best Start appointment time by the 15th December.


Reports Home
